the length of their time at Cape Cod Community College.

Expectations and Goals

We will meet with you regularly to provide guidance, coaching and encouragement based on your individual situation and will do that in a safe, positive environment. Our goal is to help you navigate your high school to college transition, move forward independently and achieve academic success.

Meetings

We will meet with you twice a month or less often as agreed and at a mutually convenient location. Texts, emails, Zoom meetings or phone calls may be used as appropriate by agreement.

When either of us contacts the other, there will be a response within 24 hours.

Mentoring meetings will focus on your goals, progress and challenges in meeting 4C's requirements. We will be open. honest and respectful in our communication and ask the same of you. We agree not to disclose anything that we discuss together unless we agree it's appropriate to do so.

Attending these meetings is vitally important and non-participation <u>could</u> affect your scholarship.

Terms of an ACCE Scholarship

- -The total ACCE scholarship award is \$4,800 for completion of your academic program. That total amount is distributed at the rate of \$80 per credit or \$240 for a three-credit course.
- -You must remain in good standing with a minimum 2.0 GPA in order to retain their scholarship.
- -Before each semester you must provide your mentor with a copy of your class schedule, a copy of the syllabus of each of your courses and a copy of your tuition bill for the term. Without these documents your scholarship will not be processed.
