

Student Guide to ACCE Mentoring

What is ACCE Mentoring:

A long term relationship focused on supporting the growth and development of our scholarship students and academic success.

Role of the ACCE Mentor:

- Serve as a coach and advisor but not a decision maker
- Provides guidance and direction as a resource person
- Encourages thinking about and reviewing goals and thoughtful planning
- Meets with student on a regular basis (typically bi-monthly)
- Assists and guides student with helpful information and suggestions resulting in well thought out decisions
- Offers strong listening skills
- Ensure student is aware of and complies with ACCE requirements
- Offers availability outside of regularly scheduled meetings

What happens at a Mentoring Session:

- Opportunity for Mentor and student to know each other
- Review course benchmarks as listed in each course syllabi
- Discuss any concerns/ issues/problems student may be experiencing
- Provide reminder of such things as advisor visits and scholarship opportunities
- Request report on all grades received to date

What is expected from me (the scholarship student)

- Timely response to schedule meetings with mentor
- Upon request, timely response to any documents that may be required
- Trust your mentor with difficult information as they have a wealth of experience to share
